Thank you for being a valuable partner and for assisting in the cooperation of the 3+2 programs with the University of Hawaii at Mānoa! On behalf of the UHM Office of Graduate Education (OGE), I am pleased to share some exciting updates on the UHM 3+2 Program.

UHM has created fifteen 3+2 partnerships with thirteen universities in China. The majority of the 3+2 programs will be officially admitting students in Fall 2016. However, three of the 3+2 programs have started program admission in Fall 2015. Four students have begun their study at UHM in the fields of public health and atmospheric sciences; two students will begin their study at UHM in Spring 2016 in the field of food sciences.

UHM OGE has launched a new website for 3+2 programs (<http://manoa.hawaii.edu/threeplustwo/>). Our mobile friendly website will provide the most updated information of UHM 3+2 programs for all partner institutions and students. On the website, partner institutions can find information on the current 3+2 programs and in what study fields. Students can find information about how to apply for the UHM programs and what assistance they will be provided when they study at UHM.

We are also pleased to have a full-time position secured for the operation of the 3+2 Program, so that there will be a designated person on the UHM side to help with coordinating all the 3+2 programs and providing administrative support to all the 3+2 students.
